The SSP Foundation, a registered charity, actively supports SSP UK colleagues who volunteer for or raise funds for charitable organisations or schools in their local community. The SSP Foundation raises and distributes funds to charitable organisations in which SSP UK colleagues are involved, and also supports projects to promote skills for young people.
